## Course Overview

### Educational Objectives

At the end of the course the participant will be able to perform accurate H & Ps on podiatric patients. Participants will be able to perform a comprehensive H & P on the pre-operative patient, identify abnormal findings requiring consultations, and understand state and federal law as it pertains to podiatric H & Ps. The participants will be able to obtain vital signs, examine head, eyes, nose and throat, lungs and abdomen, as well as musculoskeletal and neurological of the upper and lower extremities.



All participants will be required to complete a practical exam as well as a self assessment written final exam. All attendees will also use "Sim-man" and live patients during the practical portion of the course.

### Benefits of Attending This H & P Course and Doing Podiatric Patient H & Ps

Podiatrists who can admit their own patients have more control over what happens to them which results in greater continuity and better patient care.

Providing "one-stop shopping" for the patient eliminates the patient frustration of needing to see two separate physicians in order to have an elective (or non-elective) surgical procedure done. Many hospitals now require current documentation of competency for performing History and Physicals in order to "update" other physicians' H&Ps on the morning of surgery.

When you do the preoperative H & P, in the patient's eyes you are now his or her doctor not just their "foot doctor" which increases patient confidence and compliance.
